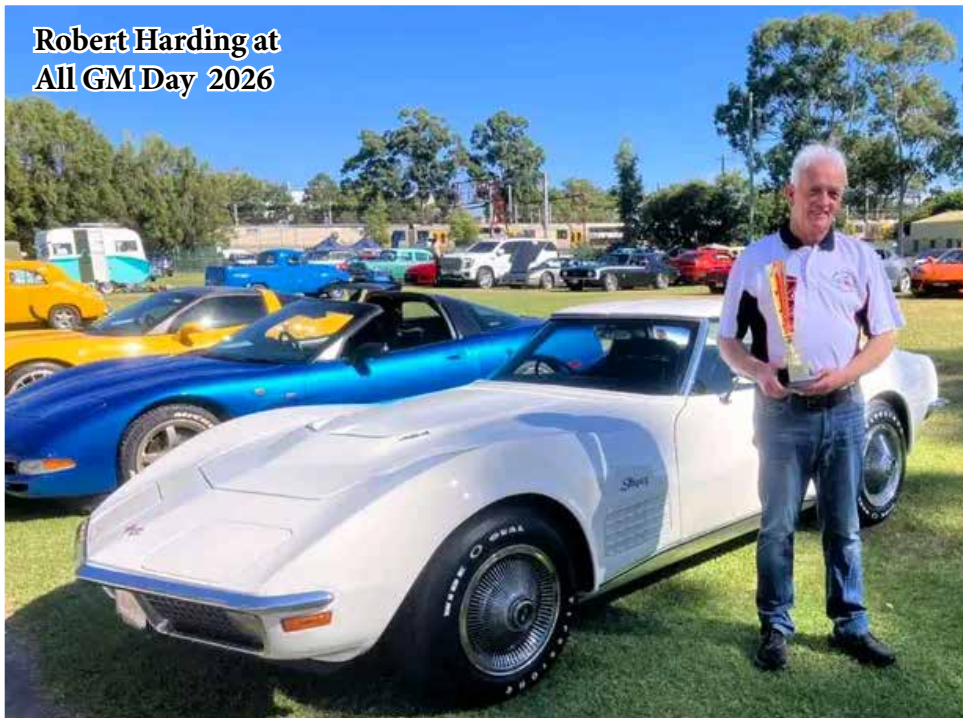

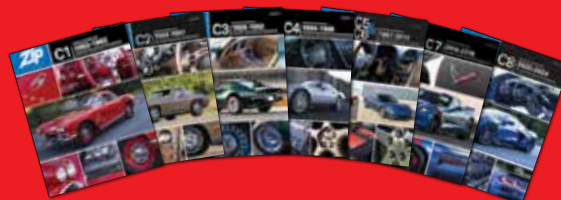

From the Treas\$ury

The usual start with the Term Deposit still locked in for some months yet at \$27,236.57 no changes here.
Some late renewals from last year with the following: 1. Mr Jarman \$75. 2. RMCGeorge \$75. 3. M.Stoker \$75.

We already have early birds sending in their monies for the Xmas in July coming up very soon.
Rob & Kim Sloan, Doug & B Ford, Deb & Neil Groat, Pauline Psaila, Jan & Pete Eldred, Jean & Pete Cox.
Wayne & Wilma Hulbert.

A good start as I have paid the deposit for the event and whilst this is booked for the usual 40 members, I've been told there is plenty of scope to increase our base numbers up to match our eager membership - so give this one some thought, it's a day time luncheon and has the advantage of being attached to the Motel. The RSL is much larger than when I've stayed there some years ago, should be good.

The month of April saw an Open of \$46,288.53 with total debits of \$1715.75 being for Mag \$1200, Post \$210.75, IT/Web \$130.00. Bis Cards \$48, Badges \$107 and the usual StG Acct fee \$20.00 - with nil deposits, making April close at \$44,572.78. At the time of printing May has no expenditure except for the Xmas in July event, but plenty of "Code 26" coming in, leaving our close for May at \$45,591.78. However, by meeting next month this will move upwards.

"Now for something else:"

When paying your "RENEWAL" - as your reference in the reference field we need YOUR "Surname", in fact for any payment like for example Xmas in July, you would put "Code26 Smith" or "Smith Code 26" and for a renewal you would just put "Smith" as the idiot Treasurer knows that \$75 is for a single renewal. Now please keep in mind that YOUR cars Rego (if H plates) requires your rego is concurrent with membership in a participating club. If you fail to renew by 30th July your rego and Green slip are nul-and-void, and more than likely your Car's Comp Insurance would be also be voided by your Insurer..

"Not For Profits"

This report as a result of the last Committee meeting, some individuals are spreading rumours etc about the ATO auditing clubs over the issue of "Sponsorship". Your club identifies itself as a "Not for Profit Local Sporting Club" and this is as close as we can come to a suitable nomenclature. There is a very sparse and vague page in the ATO website covering "Not-for-Profits" and has had NO updates since 15th April 2020. Basically we do NOT fall within the meaning as we do not do any of the following:

1. We do not have an ABN.
2. We do not have an TFN.
3. We do not use Single Touch Payroll.
4. We do not have Employees.
5. We are not registered for GST.
6. We do not pay or are registered for BAS.
7. We do not pay Super.

Having said the above, we as a club do not generally speaking operate on Sponsorship, all our monies and earnings come from members and are payments for goods and services, ie Membership, in Raffles you get a chance for a prize, or outings your subscription pays for an event or food etc. The only issue I see is for large scale Sponsorship for our Conventions, and this as far as I can see was abrogated by a member moving to have a stand alone committee complete with its own name, bank account and thankfully Treasurer who managed the financial issues for Parkes. Even so the Sponsors received advertising or Show positioning/stall for their products as per our usual operations.

If the ATO was to waste its valuable time and resources looking into us, then its the Parkes Committee etc that would be required to do a P&L and audit, and most likely show just cause as to the transactions.

Full large scale "NforPs" who operate in the Millions\$/PA and employ staff would be doing Activity Statements and returns every year, even so the Not-for-Profits page on the Website only covers them and is at best very vague.
